Conaway, Everett (2 tapes). Sold and installed processing plant equipment on Delmarva for at least three decades after World War II.

Covell, Ed (2 tapes). Poultry industry entrepreneur and political activist on behalf of poultry industry from Easton, Md., area.

Gelof, Malvin. Broiler grower during World War II in Kent Co., Del., in Hartly area, west of Dover.

Givans, David. Broiler salesman to New York market for Showell Farms, Showell, Md., from 1976-1977.

Hancock, Willis. Finance officer involved in Delmarva poultry industry, 1948-1964. Also grew up on farm in Worcester Co., Md.

Harmon, Sylvester. Nanticoke Indian who worked at a number of different jobs for Millsboro Poultry, 1939-57, and for Townsends, 1957-88.

Layfield, W. Ken. Manager of Eastern Shore Poultry Exchange in Selbyville, 1954-1969.

Lloyd, Ray. University of Delaware extension poultry specialist, 1953-1973.

McAllister, Willard (2 tapes). University of Delaware agricultural economist and marketing specialist in decades after World War II.

Marker, Charles. Hatchery owner in Dover, Del., since 1934.

Nicholson, James. University of Maryland extension poultry specialist stationed just west of Salisbury, 1952-82.

Palmer, Dan. University of Delaware extension poultry specialist, 1985-1997.

Perdue, Frank P. (2 tapes). President or chairman, Perdue Farms Inc., just east of Salisbury, Md., since 1950.

Pettyjohn, David R. Broiler grower, 1940-1982; serviceman for Townsends, 1951-1982.

Quillen, Ben. Feed mill entrepreneur, Berlin Milling in Salisbury, Md., 1945-1970.

Rabinowitz, Milton. Owned Paramount Poultry, Harbeson, Del., after World War II.

Short, Harold. Broiler grower east of Georgetown from 1949 to present.

Spicer, Charles. Lived in a chicken house apartment in Dagsboro, Del., just prior to World War II.

Street, Robert (2 tapes). Owner of Cohn and Bock feed mill operation in Princess Anne, Md., 1930s-1968.

Townsend, P. Coleman. Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of Townsends, Inc. 1993-.

Truitt, Jerry. DPI Executive Director, 1987-93.

Veterinarians: Drs. Stephen Hitchner, Hiram Lasher, Morris Cover, and Albert Cosgrove.

Walters, Cordonsal. African-American processing plant worker for Millsboro Poultry, 1938-56, and Townsends, 1961-70. Also includes a short interview with Elizabeth Hall, an African-American processing plant line worker for Townsends, 1970-90.

Willis, J. McKenny. Feed and poultry entrepreneur in Easton, Md., since 1930s.

Workman, Preston (2 tapes). Broiler grower southwest of Georgetown, mid-1930s to 1995.
